

## 2024 DPMBP Patroller Certification Requirements

### Overland (OMBA)

1. Current Overland Membership
2. Current First Aid/CPR certification
3. 2 check rides with a current Patroller
4. 1 mechanical check by a current Patroller
5. When patrolling, display approved identification as a DPMBP Patroller (this may include jerseys, placards, name tags, patches or something similar, TBD).

### Fort Collins Natural Areas (FCNA)

1. Register in the Fort Collins Engage system as a DPMBP Patroller - <https://engage.fcgov.com/d/NA/App/VolunteerApplicationDiamondPeaks>
2. Let us know that you have registered, so we can notify the FCNA Volunteer Coordinator to make you an active DPMBP volunteer in the system.
3. Once active, log into your account and sign the online waiver that should be listed in your "To Dos".
4. Pass the Sterling Volunteers background check that will be sent to you by FCNA.

### Larimer County Department of Natural Resources (LCDNR) - new requirements:

1. Create account in Larimer County Offero system: <https://offerolarimer.org/Signup>
  - a. Be sure to add your mailing address so LCDNR has an address to send your parking pass to.
2. Let us know that you have signed up for an account, so we can notify the LCDNR Volunteer Coordinator to make you a DPMBP volunteer in the system.
3. Once active as a volunteer in their system,

4. Log into your account and sign all of the waivers that are showing in your list of "To Dos" and email Julie Enderby at LCDNR ([jenderby@larimer.org](mailto:jenderby@larimer.org)) that you have completed everything and she will mail you your parking pass.

### Lory State Park (LSP)

1. No current special requirements for LSP.

### United States Forest Service (USFS)

1. Complete Good Host training (same as FCNA requirement - view video at <https://youtu.be/wMogH4L1GZQ>)
2. Sign paper or PDF waiver – sign at any DPMBP meeting or you can download the PDF ([https://overlandmtb.org/DPMBP/301b\\_OMBA\\_PatrolCrew\\_FY24.pdf](https://overlandmtb.org/DPMBP/301b_OMBA_PatrolCrew_FY24.pdf)) to sign and return.
